Trinity College Hosts Carillon Festival:

*Nightly Carillon Concerts to
Celebrate Chapel's 75th Anniversary*

Hartford, Conn., June 1, 2007—Bells will be ringing on the Trinity quadrangle June 25, 26, and 27 as the college's first Carillon Festival adds to the celebration of the Chapel's 75th anniversary.

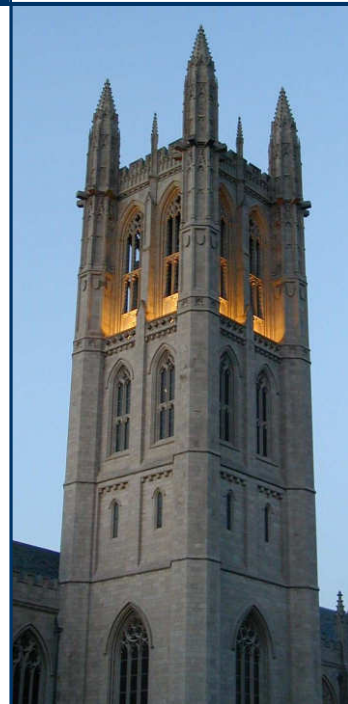
Concerts will begin at 5 p.m. during the three-day Festival and feature bell players from around the world. Listeners are encouraged to bring a picnic supper and lawn chairs and enjoy the mix of carillon and lawn entertainment scheduled each evening. Concerts will conclude at 8 p.m. each evening.

The Festival will also honor retiring College Carillonneur Daniel Kehoe who has held the post for 25 years. A special concert on the lawn at 7 p.m. featuring the Classic Brass will precede Kehoe's final concert on Wednesday, June 27th at 7:30 p.m. David Maker will assume the duties of College Carillonneur at the conclusion of the Festival.

Trinity's regular Summer Concert Music Series, now in its 58th year, will continue after the Festival each Wednesday evening through August 15 with a chamber recital in the chapel at 6 p.m. and a carillon concert outside at 7 p.m.
